Fulbright Student Grants to France: ENS Rennes

Graduating college seniors and bachelor's degree holders may apply to complete a master's degree at the prestigious and highly competitive Grande Ecole, Ecole Normale Supérieure de Rennes (ENS Rennes).

One award will be given to a candidate in the humanities or social sciences, and one award will be given to a candidate in the fundamental or applied sciences.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS	Public policy, economics, water science, complex systems engineering, physical education and sports science, computer science, cybersecurity. LENGTH OF AWARDS	Up to 24 months
BENEFITS (MAINTENANCE AND TRAVEL)	€1000 per month and a full tuition waiver from ENS Rennes. An additional €300 per month from the Franco-American Fulbright Commission, as well as a €1,200 travel allowance.
	Step 1: Interested candidates should first get in contact with the ENS Rennes International Office (<u>international@ens-rennes.fr</u>) by sending an updated résumé and short statement of purpose in English or French.
HOW TO APPLY	ENS Rennes International Office will forward the request to the appropriate academic department. Candidates will receive a reply directly from the International Office regarding their eligibility, and answers to any questions they may have about the program. Please do not be in touch with department heads directly unless requested.
	Step 2: Apply to the Fulbright Student Program through the International Institute of Education (IIE) (<u>http://us.fulbright.online.org</u>).
