■ Thesis proposal (max 1500 words):

The table tennis is introduced in Olympics Games in 1988. Table tennis in China have a short history, but it has soared up quickly in the last few decades and became the top of the world in 1995 for keeping this pole position. Many factors contribute to its legendary: the globalization, sporting educations, the Olympics, etc.; Likewise, France gained laurels and reputation during its history of table tennis, with champions like Jacques Secretin or Jean-Philippe Gatien. However, as the time progressed, it made differences and went forward in a different pace. In term of the table tennis in China and France as the research object, it is necessary to build cooperation towards history of table tennis of Sino- France.

This research needs to include a comparative history. For build a topic epistemologically correct, we must create a point of comparison, the tertium comparationis. It's the reason why we will choose the field of social-ecology, the joint research aims at tracing back to the history of table tennis in France and China, and investigating the underlying reasons of the divergence between French table tennis and Chinese one.





- 1. Based on the social-ecology, constructing a socio-ecological model towards the issue;
- 2. Combing the history of table tennis in France and China, and attempting the history stage;
- 3. Digging the veiled factors attributing to the divergent results of table tennis in France and China, from the different dimensions according to the socio-ecological model;
- 4. Highlighting a trajectory about table tennis of social history and cultural history, and changes of human mind and other transformations, and offering the reference to our history researches.

This research attempts to use the theory of social-ecology, which is based on Ecological System Theory, by Bronfenbrenner, holding the standpoint that human development is shaped by a number of systems or contexts, containing five parts: the micro-system, the meso-system, the exo-system, the macro, and the chrono-system[1].

On the basis of this theory, social-ecology, widening the horizon, changes the human development into more objectives in the society. It analyses the five parts more specific - "as a philosophical approach, social-ecology investigates the ontological, epistemological, ethical and political dimensions of the relationship between the social and the ecological, and seeks the practical wisdom that results from such reflection... In doing so, it develops an analysis that is both holistic and dialectical, and a social practice that might best be described as an eco-communitarianism"[2]. According to the explanation, the social-ecology demonstrates complex but systematic characteristics. Therefore, the research are meant to construct its own socio-ecological model on the basis of social-ecology to attain the research objectives.

Some preparation can be considered, and by means of the research method, it should be attempt to clarify the needful resources and archives, classify it, and dig it: at first, Archives of ITTF Museum (Shanghai). Secondly, Archives of CIO (Lausanne); thirdly, Archives of Chinese Federation; finally, Archives de la Fédération Française (AN – PierreFitte-sur-Seine / 20040996/boites 1 à 820).

The research aims at seeking for the various factors to influence the development of table tennis in France and China, some hypothesis are considered as followed, and then the relations with social-ecology are deeply thought: 1) Political perspective: Table tennis, in China, is not only a sport like basketball, volleyball, and etc., more importantly, it condenses the Chinese spirit and symbolizes the growth of a miniature of China in sport field. 2) Populations and educational perspective: China owning large populations, the athlete reserve of table tennis is abundant. For France, there isn't enough number of table tennis athletes reserve and this practice isn't the most popular sport; 3) Public perspective: In consideration of the symbolic meaning of table tennis, Chinese table tennis has gotten the preliminary success in public - table tennis becomes one of the most important sports. In France, the trajectory is very different but the federation have an important activity in the heart of Olympics movement.
