

ENS - China Scholarship Council (CSC) Doctoral scholarship program Call for applications 2023 is now open until February 15th, 2023!

Under the framework agreement between the group of the 4 French Ecoles Normales Supérieures (ENS) and the China Scholarship Council (CSC), ENS Rennes launches the 2022 PhD call for applications with the intention of recruiting high-level-students that wish to carry out a **Full PhD**, a **joint PhD**, a **research residency stay (PhD stay)** within one of its associated research laboratories.

Selection criteria

The selection criteria will take into account the quality of the application, the interest in the topic of research by the host laboratory in ENS Rennes, and in the existing cooperations – formal or informal - with the home university candidates (for example the PROSFER-JoRISS programmes with East China Normal University, Fudan University, Jiaotang University, Beijang University, international associated laboratories...).

2023 step by step calendar:

- Call for applications open until February 15th 2023.
- Pre-selection phase by the ENS group between February 20th and February 26th.
- Pre-selected candidates must apply online through the CSC platform specifically for the ENS-CSC Scholarship
 Program: http://apply.csc.edu.cn. (派出渠道: 与法国高师集团合作奖学金).
- ATTENTION: platform open ONLY between a certain timeline!
- Results published in June / July 2023.
- In July, the International Office at ENS Rennes will contact each successful candidate in order to prepare his/her arrival for September 2023.

Eligibility terms and conditions:

- The scholarship is for a maximum period of 4 years.
- Candidates must be of Chinese nationality, be residing in China and must not be employed outside China at the time of application.
- Successful scholarship candidates commit to returning to China upon completion of the Full PhD or visiting PhD stay
- Candidates must fulfill all admission and selection requirements put forth by ENS Rennes; they must prove to have a very good level in English and for certain domains in Human Sciences a very good level in French (B2 or C1 level).
- Full and visiting PhD students will be hosted within one of ENS Rennes' partner laboratories: http://www.ens-rennes.fr/laboratoires-partenaires/.

How do I apply?

- Identify a PhD subject which interests you and get directly in contact with the related scientific referee.
- After evaluation of all applications, the scientific referee will preselect and nominate one candidate.
- All nominations and application files must be sent to the International Relations Office at ENS Rennes before
 February 18th at the latest: international@ens-rennes.fr. Applications must only be sent through your scientific referee.

Application file and documents to be submitted

- Detailled CV (in English OR in French),
- Language proficiency certification,
- Letter of statement in English OR in French,
- Copy of applicant's passport
- The PhD supervisor's biography signed,
- A description of the thesis project signed by the PhD supervisor,
- An acceptance letter signed by the PhD supervisor which includes a brief overview of the thesis proposal and its implementation context. This letter should also be signed by the head of the host laboratory and the doctoral school.
